This is the list of ANZSCO Occupations in scope of the focus area 'Education and training'.

The focus area broadly covers occupations that require specialised knowledge and skills to:

- plan, organise, direct, control and coordinate educational and administrative aspects in educational institutions
- educate students by teaching, research and develop curricula and teaching materials and promote students' social, emotional, intellectual and physical development
- provide technical support and prepare materials to assist with teaching chemistry, earth sciences, life sciences and physical sciences in schools
- perform non-teaching duties to assist teaching staff in schools and provide care and supervision for children.

The comprehensive review includes occupations recently updated in 2021 and 2022 so that we can apply conceptual consistency across the classification.

Only occupations relevant to the focus area are included. These are listed by their current hierarchical categories in ANZSCO.
